Drive Safe ■ Use Jott



Effective July 1, 2008, the legislation prohibits drivers from using a wireless telephone while operating a motor vehicle unless the driver uses a **hands-free device**. Drivers who violate the law will face a base fine of \$20 for a first offense and \$50 for each subsequent offense.

We recognize that there are occasions when driving circumstances make talking on a mobile phone (handheld or hands-free) unsafe. In these instances, motorists should pull over or hang up to protect the safety of themselves, their passengers and others on the road.

Here are some tips to use your hands-free device and Jott safely:

1. **Trial Run:**

Practice using your phone and headset together before you drive. Familiarize yourself with the headset controls. Adjust the fit and the microphone on your headset, check the headset settings on your cell phone and stow the phone so it's out of your way but still accessible.

2. **Be Prepared:**

Program Jott and all your frequently called numbers into your cell phone. This includes your boss, your kids, babysitter and your favorite neighborhood pizza place. Don't forget about voice dialing; most phones have that option so use it as much as possible.

3. **Set Up For Success:**

Just as you check your rearview mirror and secure your seatbelt before driving, be sure to put your headset on and ensure it's connected to your phone.
